The main function of the NSSC is to provide strategic direction on the development of the Namibian Space Science and Technology agenda which include the development & implementation of Namibia Space Science Policy and Namibia Space Science Strategy.

Required Skills and Expertise

Persons wishing to serve on the NSSC should possess the following:

- **Law**

A postgraduate degree in Law or equivalent qualification.

A minimum of 5 years' experience of which 3 years should be in policy formulations and development.

Sound understanding of Namibia's legal environment especially in Science, Technology and Innovation field.

- **Information Communication Technology**

A postgraduate degree in Law or equivalent qualification.

A minimum of 5 years' experience of which 3 years should be at technical level.

Excellent understanding of the ICT infrastructure with great emphasis on BIG DATA.

In cases of nomination by a third party, candidates must give their consent for nomination. **Nominated candidates are to submit a one page motivation substantiating their suitability for this appointment together with copies of their I.D, C.V, Qualifications and academic transcript.**
