The NCRST is mandated under the Biosafety Act, 2006 (Act no. 7 of 2006) to provide for measures to regulate activities that involve the Research & Development, Production, Marketing, Transportation, Applications and other uses of genetically modified organisms (GMOs) and specific products derived from these genetically modified organisms.

Regulations that will ensure the full implementation of the Biosafety Act have been drafted through a consultative process and are now available for final review and inputs.

It is on this note that the NCRST is organizing a final stakeholders' workshop to review and finalize the drafted Biosafety regulations before submission for gazetting.

The NCRST extends this invitation to all stakeholders to participate in the final workshop which will take place on 13 October 2015, at Protea Hotel, Furstenhof.
