Research, science and technology; innovation; humanities and social sciences; policy and development; and other related multidisciplinary fields.

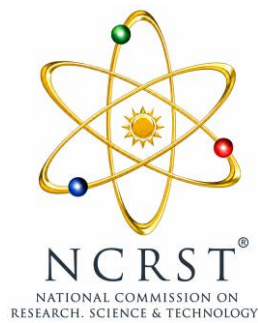
Types of manuscripts accepted:
